Information Services for Education in Tohoku University

Startup Guide

1. IDs assigned by the university

Tohokudai-ID

The Tohokudai-ID is a common ID for various information services.*

*Some services use Student-ID in place of Tohokudai-ID.

Sub-ID (Campus Wi-Fi ID)

The user ID for the Wi-Fi service is as follows: [Sub-ID]@student.tohoku.ac.jp

Google Workspace ID

This ID is for the Google services such as Gmail, Drive, Meet and Classroom.

This Gmail Service is called "DCMail" or "Email service for Students."

Microsoft365 ID

This ID is for the Microsoft365 services such as Office365, OneDrive and Teams.

*Some Information services for specific departments or schools do not apply these IDs.

2. Login to DCMail



1 Log in with your Google Workspace ID and its password from the following URL or QR code.

(2) If you are requested the 2-step verification, enter your Employee ID.

- Your initial Employee ID can be confirmed at the Tohokudai-ID notification website / letter or Integrated Electronic Authentication System.
- For the first-time login, you are requested to configure your own password in place of your initial password.

3. Login to Single Sign-On

(2) Choose the tab "auth."

3 Click "Integrated Electronic Authentication System."



④ Click "Change Password."

Your initial password should be upgrated to your own password as soon as possible for security reason.
